The desired Essentiality Certificate is as under:-

The Chairman, Ch. Hetram Johari, Education Promotion Society, Hisar had applied for the establishment of a Dental College at Village Kharakheri Distt. Fatehabad (Haryana). On careful consideration of the proposal, the Govt. of Haryana has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of dental college with 100 seats.

It is certified that:-

- a) It is desirable to establish a dental college in the public interest.
- b) Minimum 100 outdoor dental patients per day are available to begin with.
- c) Establishment of a dental college at Village Kharakheri Distt. Fatehabad (Haryana) is feasible.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the dental college as per DCI norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the DCI/Central Govt., the State Govt. shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Govt.

The NOC/Essentiality Certificate is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The Chairman, Ch. Hetram Johari, Education Promotion Society, Hisar will fulfil the norms of DCI and Government of India and get affiliation of Pt. B.D.Sharma, University of Health Sciences, Rohtak before starting the Dental College.
2. The Society will submit a Bank Guarantee of Rs. 1.50 Crore in favour of Haryana Govt. before starting the course/before making admission in the college.
3. The Society will comply with the instructions/directions of DCI, Govt. of India and Govt. of Haryana/Affiliating University issued from time to time.
